OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT



CLEAN project focuses on **promoting energy efficiency and sustainable territorial planning in the South Adriatic area by leveraging the experiences of the EU Covenant of Mayors for Climate and Energy (CoM)** –a network with more than 11.600 cities– that requires signatories to prepare a «Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plan» (SECAP).



It seeks to leverage the experiences and best practices of the Covenant of Mayors network to develop a tailored strategy to further extend the Covenant of Mayors and practices in the program area, fostering collaboration among public officers from both sides of the Adriatic.

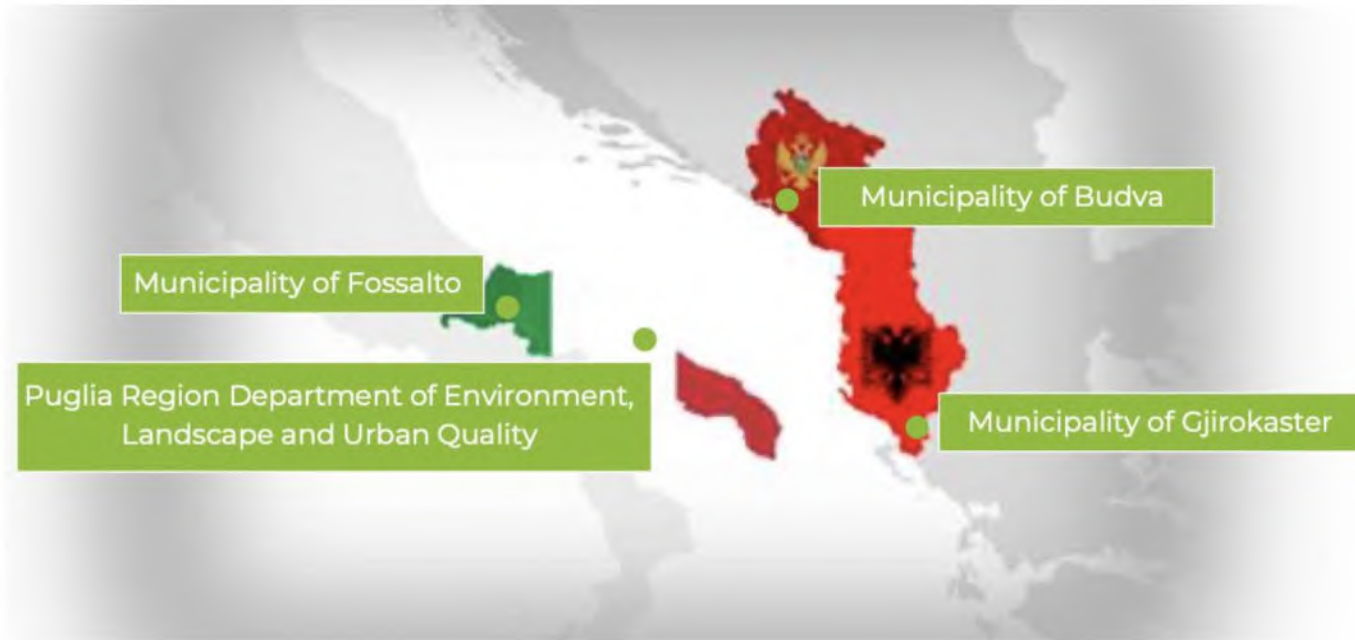
